GUIDANCE NOTES

1. Annual Fee to be paid on application.
2. Payment of fee does not entitle the applicant to any rights until the Application is approved by the Board of the Association.
3. On completion of form please forward by post to the above address or deliver to the Secretary.
4. Clearance from another Association is to be delivered to the Secretary.

FULL RIGHTS MEMBERSHIP

A Member in this category is entitled to the right to vote, the right to stand for election and all other rights as provided by the Objects and Rules.

Senior Active: to be used by an applicant over the age of 18 years who currently holds a Referee's Accreditation issued by the National Referees Accreditation Scheme.

Junior Active: to be used by an applicant over the age of 14 years and under the age of 18 years who currently holds a Referee's Accreditation issued by the National Referees Accreditation Scheme.

Non-Active: to be used by the applicant who currently holds a Referee's Accreditation issued by the National Referees Accreditation Scheme, but does not wish to be considered for any Refereeing Appointments.

RESTRICTED RIGHTS MEMBERSHIP

Preliminary: to be used by an applicant who has commenced the Level 1, National Referees Accreditation Scheme, but has not completed that Level. Preliminary members shall have all the rights of the members of the Association except they shall not be eligible for election to any office in the Association.

Honorary: A person voted as an Honorary Member by the Members at an Annual General Meeting and whose nomination appeared on the Notice Paper for that meeting. This category of Membership applies only until the following Annual General Meeting, does not have voting rights, and cannot stand for any position, but is otherwise bound by the Objects and Rules, and the Code of Conduct.

Associate: A person who has cause to join the Association by completing a Level One National Referees Accreditation for the purpose of obtaining a Coaching Certificate with the Australian Rugby League. Such member shall be a non-active member and will be ineligible to vote at Association meetings or to occupy official positions.
